Three Levels of Support

Tier 3: Intensive, highly individualized supports

Tier 2: Smaller groups lessons and therapies, formal consultation or more robust behavior supports.

Tier 1:- Universal standard supports are those provided to all students

- Individualized Behavior **Intervention** Plan identified following Functional Assessment
- Enhanced staffing likely

Tier 2

- Behavior **Support** Plan with enhanced strategies for support

- Students reinforced for following school rules
- Universal token system

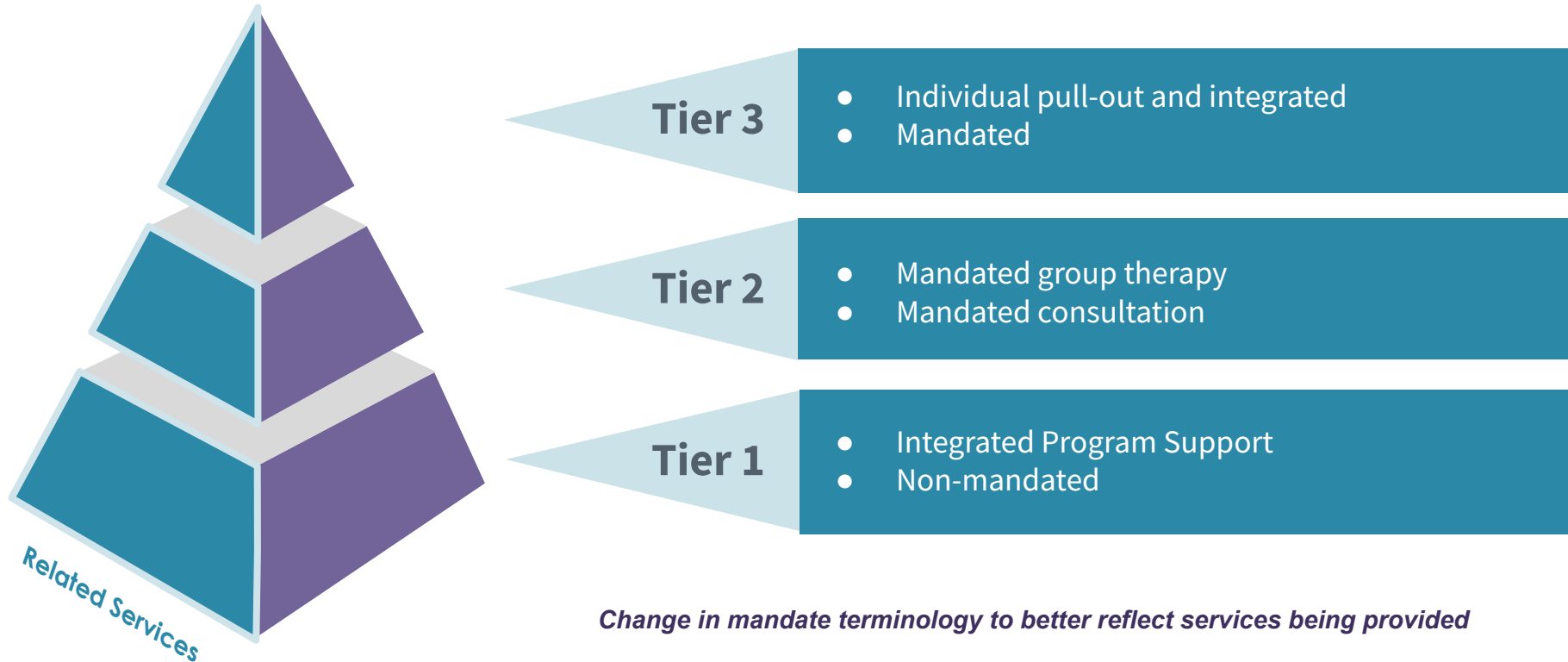

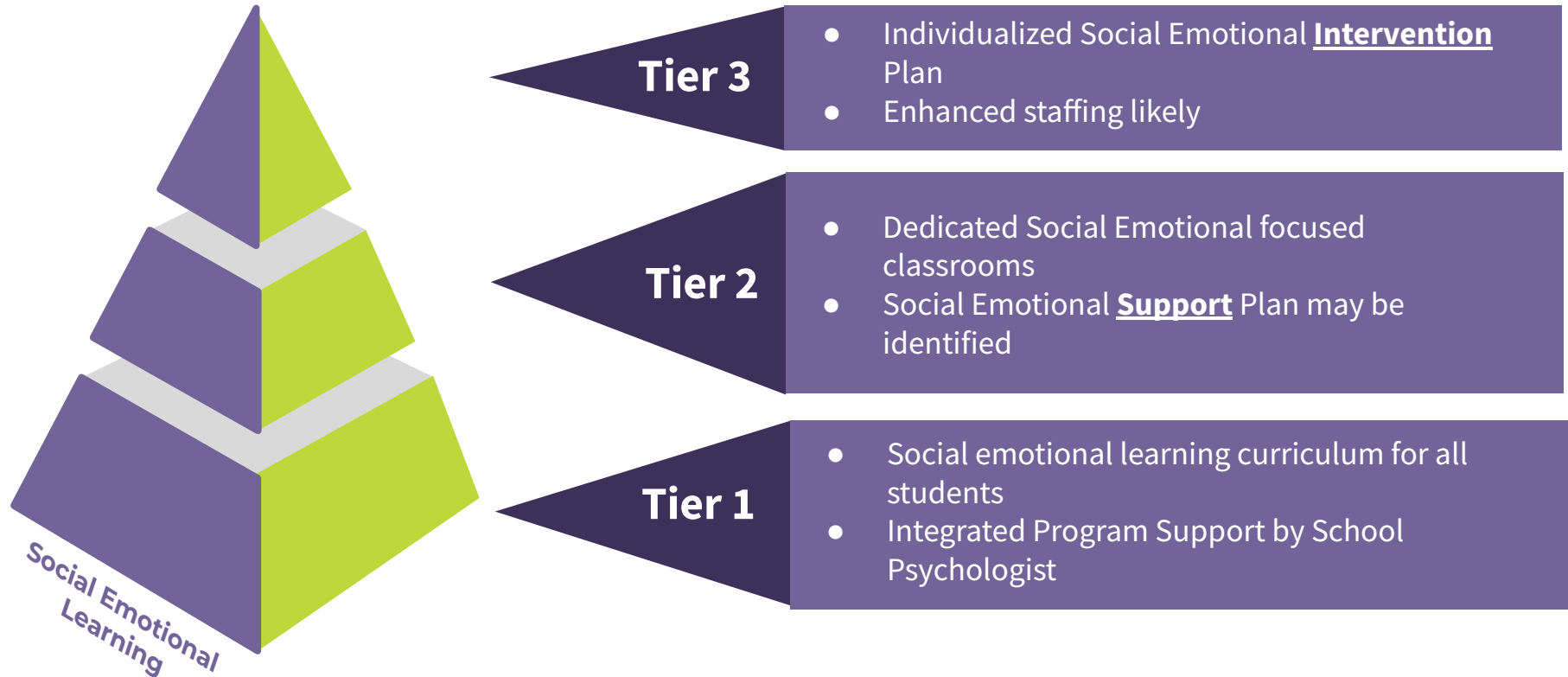
Students earn Bancroft Bucks for following the rules. They can cash in these bucks for prizes at the BUCK STOP (next to the Market).

Classroom Level Clinics

Classwide progress and standard supports are reviewed for consistency.

Student Level Clinics

May lead to IEP meeting if recommended adjustments warrant.
